INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETION OF STATEMENT

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Section 17923 Business & Professions Code

- a) Any person who is a general partner in a partnership that is or has been regularly transacting business under a fictitious business name may, upon withdrawing as a general partner, file a statement of withdrawal from the partnership operating under a fictitious business name. The statement shall be executed by the person filing the statement in the same manner as a fictitious business name statement and shall be filed with the county clerk of the county where the partnership filed its fictitious business name statement.
- b) The statement shall include:
 - 1) The fictitious business name of the partnership.
 - 2) The date on which the fictitious business name statement for the partnership was filed and the county where filed.
 - 3) The street address of its principal place of business in this state or, if it has no place of business in this state, the street address of its principal place of business outside of this state, if any.
 - 4) The full name and residence of the person withdrawing as partner.
- c) The statement of withdrawal from the partnership operating under a Fictitious Business Name shall be published in the same manner as the Fictitious Business Name Statement and an affidavit showing the publication of the statement shall be filed with the County Clerk after the completion of the publication.
- d) The withdrawal of a general partner does not cause a Fictitious Business Name Statement to expire if the withdrawing partner files a statement of withdrawal in accordance with subdivisions (a) and (b) and the requirement of subdivision (c) is satisfied.”

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NOTICE TO PERSON(S) – Section 17924, Business & Professions Code

- (1) Within 30 days after filing the Withdrawal from Partnership Operating under Fictitious Business Statement with the County Clerk, the registrant shall publish the statement in a legal newspaper once a week for four successive weeks and file an Affidavit of Publication with the County Clerk within 30 days after publication has been accomplished. The statement should be published in such county in a newspaper that circulates in the area where the business is conducted. (Section 17917 B & P Code).
- (2) Any person who executes, files, or publishes any Fictitious Business Name Statement, knowing that such statement is false, in whole or in part, is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000). Business & Professions Code Section 17930).
